



AHCC Schooling Show Rules

And
AWARD CLASSIFICATION

On all questions concerning the point system and Year End Awards, the ruling of the Points Committee shall be final.

1. MEMBERSHIP REQUIREMENT

- A. Rider must be a current Associate or AHA Affiliate member of AHCC in good standing. Rider may not collect a Year End Award (YEA) if, at the time of the Awards presentation, the rider is more than 30 days past due on any money or debts owed to AHCC.
- B. No horse nomination required. Points will accrue on the date of payment and for the remainder of the calendar year.

2. SHOWS

- A. A list of AHCC Schooling shows shall be made available to the membership at the beginning of the show season.

3. POINT VALUES

- A. Classes will count the following points:

1 st	2 nd	3 rd	4 th	5 th	6 th	7 th -8 th
7	5	4	3	2	1	1/2

- B. Division Championship based on cumulative points within a division will not count, since the rider or horse are not being re-judged (i.e. Day End Champions).

Each division will be awarded ONE Day End Champion/Reserve Champion (Divided classes will be pointed as one class (i.e. 12 & under Split into an A, B, C class due to a large amount of entries)

- C. Riders must show in 50% in their division for performance and/or halter awards. Rider may show on different horses in the same division to qualify for a Year End Award in that division (i.e. 50% shows in open walk/trot/jog, and/or 50% shows in age appropriate walk/trot/jog). Riders to be awarded unless otherwise noted (Green Horse and Senior Horse must show in 50% shows to qualify for a Year End Award in the Green Horse and Senior Horse Divisions). Riders of Senior and Green horses must meet 1. A of Membership requirement.

4. SCHOOLING SHOW YEAR END AWARDS (YEA):

- A. Each division will be awarded Championship through sixth (6th) place.

- B. Divisions:

Senior Horse (horse only awarded)

We would like to keep the atmosphere of these schooling shows relaxed, with our focus on good performances by both horse and rider. Therefore, we do not allow show clothes. Thank you for your cooperation.

1. Children **must** be under adult supervision at all times.
2. **No** Pets allowed.
3. No smoking in barns or arena.
4. Riders born on December 1st shall assume the greater age on that date.
5. Stallions are **NOT** allowed.
6. **Green Horse:** Must be in 1st or 2nd year of showing, and can be shown in all classes. Trainers are allowed. Riders of green horses are to be at least 13 years old with more than two years experience/can not cross enter into green riders division .
7. **Green Riders:** Must be in 1st or 2nd year of showing. Green Riders can show in all age appropriate classes.
8. **Walk Trot/Jog:** classes are for those riders who have never been judged at a canter.
9. **Trainers:** Are allowed to ride in age appropriate classes, but will only be judged in Green horse. (Trainers will wear their number upside down in all other classes they enter). A Trainer is a person who is remunerated for their services.
10. **Leadline Riders:** to be led by an adult **18 or over**. Rider must be under 8 years old as December 1st
11. **Safety Helmets & FOOTWEAR:** ALL riders MUST wear shoes with a small heel (no sneakers), and all riders MUST wear SEI/ASTM safety helmet.
12. Horses may be shown in double bridle, Pelham, or snaffle with martingale. NO DRAW REINS, GERMAN MARTINGALES OR TIE-DOWNS ALLOWED.
13. Attire and/or tack with **farm logos are NOT allowed** in the show ring while classes are being judged.
14. **Classes** will be split if there are more than eight (8) entries. Canter classes in small arenas, may be divided to canter, but judged as one class.
15. **Senior Horse:** Horse must be over 20 years of age as of January 1st of the show year. Any age rider permitted.
16. **Animal Abuse:** Will NOT be tolerated. Anyone found abusing an animal will be asked to leave and forfeit all entry monies and prizes.
17. **Gate Holds:** Gate holds will be allowed only if ring steward and/or secretary have been notified, and are two minutes.
18. **Coggins papers** within one year, and **proof of rabies** are required

SPECIAL YEAR END AWARDS

The AHCC HIGH POINT SCHOOLING SERIES SENIOR HORSE

1. Open to all qualified members of AHCC in good standing.
2. Membership qualifications are the same as for the AHCC annual Awards requirements.
3. Horse must be 20 years or older.
4. Awarded to the horse (any breed) accruing the most points, at AHCC schooling shows.
5. In case of a tie, the oldest horse will be declared the winner.
6. The Winner keeps this trophy until December 31st and returns it to the current Banquet chairman.

The AHCC HIGH POINT SCHOOLING SERIES RIDER

1. Open to all qualified members of AHCC in good standing.
2. Membership qualifications are the same as for the AHCC annual Awards requirements.
3. Awarded to the rider accruing the most points, at AHCC schooling shows.
4. The Winner keeps this trophy until December 31st and returns it to the current Banquet chairman.

SPECIAL AWARDS

The Board of Directors will give Special Awards at its discretion.
